may have been built with a recliner strap for the second row center seat that may

bind on the trim cover surface.

The suspect period began on February 24, 2021, when the first eight passenger vehicle was produced, and ended on October 11, 2021, when sort procedures were implemented in vehicle production. The vehicle population was determined through

vehicle production records.

Similar vehicles not included in this recall were built after the suspect period, were repaired prior to release from the production plant, or are seven passenger vehicles

and not equipped with a second row center seat position.

Description of Noncompliance:

Description of the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard ("FMVSS") 207 S4.3 requires that, Noncompliance: "Except for a passenger seat in a bus or a seat having a back that is adjustable only for the comfort of its occupants, a hinged or folding occupant seat or occupant seat back shall be equipped with a self-locking device for restraining the hinged or folding seat or seat back, ..." Vehicles built with a seat recliner strap that binds on the trim cover surface may not meet the self-locking requirement.

Description of the Safety Risk: A binding center seat recliner strap may prevent the seat back from locking

into an upright position. If the seat can not be locked in an upright position, there is an increased risk of injury in a crash to the occupant of the seat.

Identification of Any Warning Inability to lock the seat in an upright position. The seat will remain in a fold

that can Occur: flat position unless an occupant applies force to hold it in the upright position.

- On November 3, 2021, FCA US LLC ("FCA US") Technical Safety and Regulatory Compliance recognized a vehicle build issue existed on certain vehicles related to the seat back self-locking function, potentially not in compliance with FMVSS No. 207.
- On November 18, 2021, FCA US determined, through the Vehicle Regulations Committee, to conduct a voluntary safety recall of the affected vehicles.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to

inspect and, if necessary, replace the rear center seat recliner strap.

FCA US has a longstanding policy and practice of reimbursing owners who have incurred the cost of repairing a problem that subsequently becomes the subject of a field action. To ensure consistency, FCA US, as part of the owner letter, will request that customers send the original receipt and/or other adequate proof of payment to the company for confirmation of the

expense.

How Remedy Component Differs The remedy component will be a rear center seat recliner strap that does
