seat frame may be incomplete.

Description of the Safety Risk: If the vehicle is involved in a collision, the weld could break, causing the seat

back position to fail, which can increase the risk of an injury.

Description of the Cause: During production, the protective lens of the laser welder became

contaminated with weld spatter, inhibiting the welder's monitoring system to detect and judge the laser input necessary to sufficiently complete the weld.

As of February 9, 2023, Honda has received no warranty claims related to the issue and no reports of injuries or deaths related to this issue.
