Identify How/When Recall Condition Improper molding of the fuel tank at the supplier occurred from 4/7/2022 was Corrected in Production: to 4/9/2022. The molding processes were corrected in production at the supplier on 4/10/2022. The recalled component may have been installed in the subject vehicles produced from 4/12/2022 to 4/26/2022. Model year 2022 Sorento PHEV vehicles produced after 4/26/2022 were equipped with a properly molded fuel tank.
