• On November 17, 2021, FCA US LLC ("FCA US") Technical Safety and Regulatory Compliance recognized an incomplete SLM software update existed on certain vehicles resulting in one or both headlamps being inoperable, potentially not in compliance with FMVSS No. 108.

• On December 02, 2021, FCA US determined, through the Vehicle Regulations Committee, to conduct a voluntary safety recall of the affected vehicles.

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Description of Remedy :

Description of Remedy Program :	FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to reprogram the SLM.
	FCA US has a longstanding policy and practice of reimbursing owners who have incurred the cost of repairing a problem that subsequently becomes the subject of a field action. To ensure consistency, FCA US, as part of the owner letter, will request that customers send the original receipt and/or other adequate proof of payment to the company for confirmation of the expense.
	This recall is not the result of a design defect but rather an incomplete component software update. The remedy includes correct software that meets the FMVSS 108 Lamps, reflective devices, and associated equipment requirements.
