Chronology :

• On June 21, 2022, FCA US LLC ("FCA US") Technical Safety and Regulatory Compliance ("TSRC") opened an investigation into 2022-2023 MY Jeep Grand Cherokee and Jeep Grand Cherokee L vehicles built with a potentially missing dashboard airbag warning label.

• From June 2022, through April 2023, FCA US TSRC reviewed vehicle records and met with FCA US engineering to review manufacturing and supplier data to understand the condition and determine the suspect population.

• On April 12, 2023, FCA US TSRC recognized that a missing required passenger airbag warning label may not meet the requirements of FMVSS 208 Occupant Crash Protection.

• On May 4, 2023, FCA US determined, through the Vehicle Regulations Committee, to conduct a voluntary safety recall of the affected vehicles.

Description of Remedy :

Description of Remedy Program :	FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles. For vehicles that have been sold, FCA US will mail the owners a representative copy of the required label within the owner notification. For vehicles that have not been sold, FCA US will inspect, and, if necessary, install the required label.
	FCA US has a longstanding policy and practice of reimbursing owners who have incurred the cost of repairing a problem that subsequently becomes the subject of a field action. To ensure consistency, FCA US, as part of the owner letter, will request that customers send the original receipt and/or other adequate proof of payment to the company for confirmation of the expense.
	This recall is not related to a part defect but rather a manufacturing issue. The remedy is to notify all affected vehicle owners and/or inspect and install missing labels if necessary.
