Chronology:

In mid of October, 2022, Porsche became aware of instrument panel conformity of production test results that deviated from specification. The potential irregularity was related to a test at high test temperature.

In order to analyze possible effects of this issue on the deployment behavior of the passenger airbag and the behavior of instrument panel components, further tests were carried out in a certain temperature range.

On November 24, 2022, further test results indicated a possible influence on passenger air bag deployment. This was further analyzed.

In parallel to this, the affected production period and the resulting particular batch was identified.

On November 30, 2022, Porsche decided to recall the subject vehicles.
