A customer complaint was submitted to NHTSA in early October, which initiated an investigation into awning deployments on the Revel chassis. Winnebago continued to work with the awning supplier, Carefree of Colorado, to understand the potential scope and consequence of the issues identified. A second VOQ on a Revel chassis was received in mid-October. In early November, Carefree of Colorado notified Winnebago that their testing had identified a defect with the gearbox housing in their supplied awnings which they reported to NHTSA. After confirming the scope of finished units impacted by the gearbox issue, the Product Safety Committee determined all Revels from MY20 to MY23 may have been assembled with defective awnings from Carefree. Winnebago is filing this notice of defect to capture Winnebago units impacted by Carefree of Colorado recall 22E-094.

Winnebago is not aware of any injuries or deaths associated with this issue.
