Description of Noncompliance :

	For the affected vehicles, it is possible to trigger the operation of a LIN roof console and movement of sunroof with a testball, defined by FMVSS118. The requirement on the FMVSS118 may not be met.
FMVSS 1 :	118 - Power-operated window systems
FMVSS 2 :	NR
Description of the Safety Risk :	Although anti-pinch protection is in place, the sunroof could be activated with the FMVSS118 test steel ball, which is contrary to the regulation.
Description of the Cause :	After the improvement of the touch switch, the slider area became too sensitive.

July 20, 2022: Topic was presented to the Volkswagen Product Safety Committee, which decided a recall due to noncompliance with FMVSS118.
